Life Without Barriers supports proposed child protection Bill aiming to improve permanency options for children in out-of-home-care

Leading social purpose organisation and out of home care provider Life Without Barriers (LWB) welcomes the NSW Government's proposed legislation to improve the current practices for guardianship and open adoption in order to increase the availability of permanency options for children in out-of-home-care.

LWB NSW State Director Roderick Best said that LWB welcomes all attempts, especially in Children's Week, to help children in out-of-home care secure safe and permanent homes. The Bill tabled in Parliament by Minister Goward this week attempts to address some of the big legislative issues currently faced by children in out-of-home-care.

"It is really important to see the emphasis in this Bill on involving families through alternative dispute resolution as well as removing court processes that impede reaching orders to help a child have a long term forever home," Mr Best said.

"What we want is to ensure vulnerable children can be settled into a long term, loving, nurturing home. These things have been critical to our work in Life Without Barriers and what we continue to strive for."

"For a number of years now we have been seeking to drive an evidence based, trauma informed practice and are fully supportive of changes to achieve this. The underlying principles, as they drive these changes, should be applauded as absolutely the right way to go."
