In addition to the Australian Government Department of Health 'in reach' vaccination options for people with disability in residential care (Phase 1a), and access through General Practitioners and large Hospital Hubs, there are now state-based options for vaccination becoming available.

Vaccination is voluntary, however, Life Without Barriers' Vaccination Status Policy requires staff to advise of their vaccination status. To do this or update your vaccination status, call the
