Most injuries suffered by children occur in and around the home. Young children are vulnerable to injuries as they begin to explore their environment because they are unable to recognise danger or take action to keep themselves safe. While it may not be possible to make your home completely safe at all times, you can take steps to reduce the risk of injury and make your home a safer place for children.

Is your child's bed/cot safe? (children under 9 years should not sleep in bunk beds, and cots need to meet the Australian Standard (AS/NZS 2172). Check that cot rails are between 50mm and 95mm apart to avoid head entrapment)	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Is the cot mattress firm, flat and does it fit snugly to avoid your child from becoming wedged?	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>

Do you keep your child away from Quad bikes and farm bikes? (Many burns and crush injuries result when these types of vehicles overturn – always supervise your child.)	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
