

When to call an ambulance for a customer with Covid-19 being supported in a Northcott home

The signs below are not specific to Covid-19, but are of special concern in a person with Covid-19.

If someone is showing any of these signs,* seek emergency medical care by calling Triple Zero (000) immediately:

- trouble breathing
- persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- new confusion or difficult to rouse
- inability to wake or stay awake
- pale, grey, or blue-coloured skin, lips, or nail beds, depending on skin tone
- cold and clammy or pale and mottled skin
- little or no urine output
- coughing up blood.

Notify the 000 operator that you are seeking care for someone who has Covid-19.

Call the customer's GP or HealthDirect on 1800 022 222 for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to the customer.
