Welcome to another Life Without Barriers (LWB) newsletter for staff transferring from the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to LWB.

Inductions for Eastern Melbourne are now complete! We were so thrilled to meet so many of you over Day 1, 2 and 3 inductions and together we completed 27 inductions!

Technology Updates - as we prepare for the transfer of services to Life Without Barriers, our team will be visiting all transferring properties to update technology and infrastructure ahead of Day 1. We have a Frequently Asked Questions section on our website. You can find the answers to previously asked questions [here](#). Some common questions and answers are below:

Q. What award are staff under?

A. *The Disability Services Enterprise Agreement 2018 – 2022 will apply to DHHS staff members seconded to LWB.*

Q. How do we access LWB's Policies and Procedures?

A. *In each house there will be an LWB Residential Services Practice Manual (RSPM), there will also be a digital copy on the LWB Victorian Disability Accommodation Supports (VDAS) Intranet. All LWB policies and procedures are also on the intranet.*

Q. Will I get an LWB identification (ID) Card?

A. *The provision of an identification card will be dependent upon the requirements of your role. If your position involves visiting clients or key stakeholders, or you are representing LWB in another capacity, you may receive an ID card.*

This has been a great opportunity to get to know the people we will be working with, and for DHHS staff to get to know LWB.
