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## STEP 1

### I MEET WITH LIFE WITHOUT BARRIERS

My family or supporters and I will meet with Life Without Barriers to talk about:

- My support needs at home
- What Supported Independent Living (SIL) funding is and what it involves
- What other information about me will help explain my support needs
- How my Supported Independent Living (SIL) Quote will be created
- Any questions I have



## STEP 2

### MY SIL QUOTE IS CREATED

After I meet with Life Without Barriers, they will use the information that my family, supporters and I shared to create my SIL Quote. This is an important document that includes information about:

- My support needs at home
- How much funding I require to support these needs



## STEP 3

### STAFF REVIEW MY SIL QUOTE

My SIL Quote will be checked by my Operational Manager and House Supervisor who look after the house I live in, to ensure all the right information is included in my SIL Quote.



## STEP 4

### LIFE WITHOUT BARRIERS CREATES A 'ROSTER OF CARE' FOR MY HOUSE

Once every Participant in my house has a SIL Quote prepared, Life Without Barriers will create a 'Roster of Care'. This is another important document that outlines the needs of every person in my house to make sure there is the right roster of staff to support everyone.

The Roster of Care is one of a number of documents that will be sent with my SIL Quote to support my funding application.



## STEP 5

### MY SIL QUOTE IS SENT TO AND APPROVED BY THE NDIA

Once my SIL Quote is finished it will be sent to the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA), who will look at the information about my support needs at home and approve my SIL funding. My SIL funding will become part of the funding in my NDIS plan, provided by my current support staff who are transferring to Life Without Barriers with me.



## STEP 6

### MY SIL FUNDING IS REVIEWED EACH YEAR OR IF MY NEEDS CHANGE

After 12 months, or if my support needs at home change a lot, my SIL funding is reviewed by the NDIA to make sure it still meets my needs.
